

OUT OF PROVINCE REGISTRATIONS



WHAT YOU NEED **BEFORE** you can register your child:

- Original birth certificate or Canadian Passport for your child
 - If you do not have the birth certificate you must apply to your child's birth province for a new one (there may be a cost involved)

- BC Care Card/ BC ID Card for parent and child **PLUS** one (1) piece of identification from the list below

- If you **do not have** a BC Care Card/BC ID Card:
 - **Go to: Service BC**, 40 Calgary Avenue, Penticton, 250-487-4200
 - Apply and **obtain a stamped application** for BC Care Card/BC ID Card for parent **AND** child (Note: you do not have to wait three months to apply. You can apply right away but you will not receive medical for three months)
 - **PLUS** you will need three (3) pieces of identification from the list below

Examples of identification **with your new BC address** (we NEED one(1) piece if you already have a BC Care Card/ID Card for yourself **and** your child **OR** three (3) pieces if you only have your stamped application for a BC Care Card for yourself **and** your child)

Examples
of different
types of
identification.

- Copy of lease with new BC address
- Copy of purchase agreement of your new home / mortgage papers
- Copy of mortgage
- Letter from landlord confirming your residency and local address
- Interim BC driver's licence with new BC address
- Utility bill with new local address
- Cell phone bill showing new address
- Government correspondence with new address
- Banking information showing new address
- Post office change of address
- Proof of employment or payslip from employer with new address
- Piece of mail (other than School District 67 mail) with new address
- Copy of Insurance Policy – house, car, rental, or other
