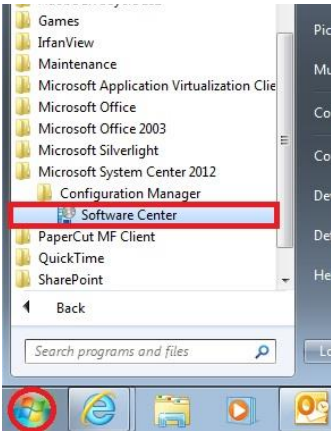


Installing and Uninstalling Software using Microsoft System Center

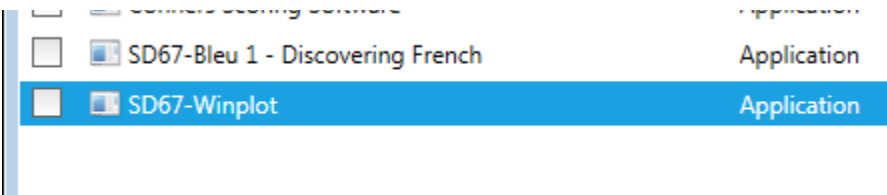
Typically software comes in two types: an installation that requires no interaction from you, the user, and an installation that requires you to make choices and clicks.

Installation requiring no User Interaction:

1. Click on Start/All Programs/Microsoft System Center 2012/Configuration Manager/Software Center



2. Select the software that you would like installed by clicking on the name of the program. This will highlight it in blue. (Note: the box to the left will not be checked)



3. Click the Install Selected button in the bottom right corner



4. *The Software Center screen stays on the top of your desktop. You need to minimize the Software Center screen to see the next steps. To minimize, click the minimize button on the top right.

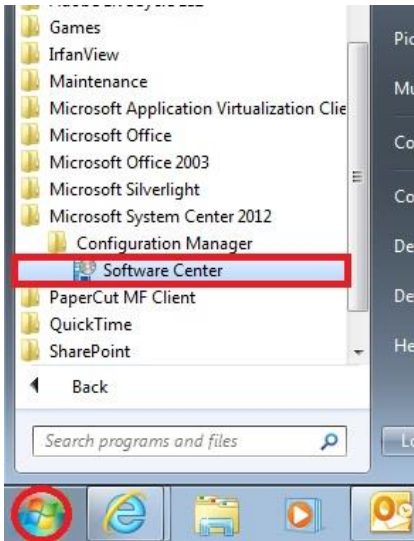


5. After your software has installed, it will no longer appear on the Available Software list.

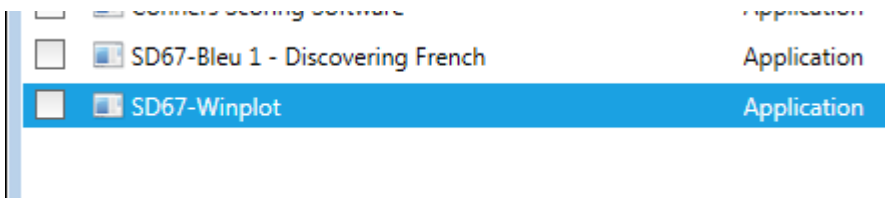
Installing Software with User Interaction

Some software installations require more involvement from you. In general, you will need to do the following:

1. Click on Start/All Programs/Microsoft System Center 2012/Configuration Manager/Software Center



2. Select the software that you would like installed by clicking on the name of the program. This will highlight it in blue. (Note: the box to the left will not be checked)



3. Click the Install Selected button in the bottom right corner



4. *The Software Center screen stays on the top of your desktop. You need to minimize the Software Center screen to see the next steps. To minimize, click the minimize button on the top right.



5. Choose the Setup Language and click OK

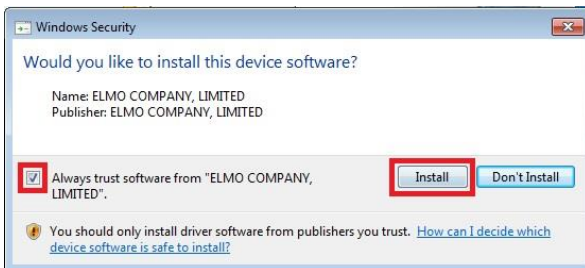


6. Read through dialog boxes for all instructions and click Next.

7. Read through, click to Accept, then Next to the license agreement if you comply with its terms.



8. If Windows Security asks whether you would like to Install, select “Always trust software...” and click the Install button.



9. Keep reading and clicking Next.

10. You will finally get to a completion box where you can click Finish. You may have to restart your computer, depending on the application.



Uninstalling Software

1. If you want to uninstall the software at any time, follow the same path: Start/All Programs/Microsoft System Center 2012/Configuration Manager/Software Center
2. Click on the Installed Software tab, highlight the software you would like to uninstall, then click the Uninstall button in the bottom right.
